CONTINUE TO OFFER FLEXIBILITY

Just as officers do in-person, it's important to consider a member's workload and schedule to make accommodations through flexible programming. Events offered at different times and days are likely to attract a higher volume of attendees. Similarly, switching up the types of events to be more diverse in nature keeps programming new and exciting.

MAINTAIN CHAPTER GROWTH

Membership recruitment and retention programs need to be customized to the reality of the chapter; this means efforts to welcome new members and maintain existing members will look different than ever before. By utilizing the virtual ceremony resources found in Officer Portal the chapter can continue to welcome new servant leaders via ongoing recruitment efforts throughout the year.

WORK HARD, PLAY HARD

Create moments of engagement by developing fun Kahoot quizzes about APO, school, or pop culture topics that chapter members follow. Tactics like this help generate brotherhood outside of fellowship events and can even be a friendly competition! Purchase one to three physical or e-gift cards for restaurants in your area and award them to members with the most points at the end of the semester.

NURTURE PERSONAL CONNECTIONS

Making a difference in the world alongside your friends is an experience that is unique to Alpha Phi Omega. Continue the tradition of building personal connections made in APO by organizing an alumni panel video call where members can ask career and volunteer-related questions.

REMIND MEMBERS OF BENEFITS

As we recognize these connections, it's important to also recognize and remind one another of all that brings us together through Alpha Phi Omega - service to our campuses and communities, developing our leadership, fostering strong relationships and so much more.
